



Smoke Free Policy

Rationale

- To ensure children and staff are free from the risk of passive smoking.
- To educate parents and staff on the dangers of smoking.
- To comply with the Smoke free Environments Act 1990.

Guidelines

- Smoking may not take place inside the building; within the children's play area outside, or anywhere within the Centre grounds.
- Staff and parents must not smoke at any time while supervising children, including while on an excursion or at any time when the children are present.
- Visitors, students, parents, whanau, caregivers, trades people and anyone else on the premises are expected to comply with these requirements.
- Employees are responsible for ensuring these requirements are met at all times.
- A "no smoking" sign will be displayed at all times at the Centre
- This policy will be reviewed when circumstances change regarding the upcoming legislation change and/or annually.
